

1.6 Academic Calendar

As we are aware that the academic calendar of a Higher Education institution (HEI) is a schedule that lists all the events that are scheduled to take place during an academic year, such as the commencement of classes, examinations, vacations, the last day of the Semester, etc. The Academic Calendar provides complete visibility of the planned events throughout the year for all the stakeholders, including students. Releasing the calendar in advance ensures that academic activities are conducted as per the plan. This helps in promoting quality teaching-learning and research.

Koteshwor Multiple Campus (KMC) has been executing a comprehensive academic schedule through its annual academic calendar ensuring all aforementioned activities. KMC has achieved its aims to establish a standardized academic calendar that ensures educational activities run smoothly and that students can plan their studies. It also helps to balance workloads for students and teachers. Even it has become successful to streamline the current variations in admission, tuition, examination schedules, and result publication of university. KMC academic calendar becomes successful to track in right path out of chaotic and disordered functioning of academic programs.

Annual operational calendar, prepared under the chairpersonship of Campus Chief and team members of Academic Committee of KMC. It is designed for the smooth operation of classes of all levels of Tribhuvan University following annual and semester systems. When National Examination Board declares result of the Class 12 by the end of Shrawan, then there is the provision of admission procedures in Bachelor Level First Year. It prolongs upto one month and Campus will conduct entrance exams and admissions for students within Ashoj. Additionally, student registration will take place in Falgun, and academic activities will commence from the first week of Mangsir. There are the provisions of three Terminal Examinations, result date, sports meet, field visit, scholarship, remedial classes etc. Calendar is prepared considering the credit hour of the curriculum. KMC Academic Committee meeting has expressed the intention to advance the academic sessions based on a consolidated calendar as usual in the past.

In a recent move to streamline academic operations, Tribhuvan University has officially approved and implemented a new annual academic calendar, effective from the academic session 2081 This decision, ratified by the Standing Committee of the Academic Council mandates all institutes,

faculties, constituent campuses, central departments, departments, and programs under the university to adhere to the newly structured schedule. KMC has prepared its annual operational calendar by considering the provisions of Calendar.

Academic Calendar Formulation Process and Rationale

Academic calendars will be approved for 1 year/ Semester in advance and go through the following stages of approval:

1. Campus Administration collects programs from all departments and sections.
2. Once collected the programs, the file is submitted to the meeting of Academic Committee.
3. Once approved by the academic committee, the calendar is recommended to the Campus Chief for review who then recommends to the Internal Quality Assurance Committee (IQAC).
4. Then it goes for execution. It becomes mandatory to all concerned stakeholders abide by the provisions of academic calendar.

1. Introduction

Result assessment is an important academic activity that helps institutions evaluate student performance, identify academic gaps, and improve teaching-learning strategies. This report presents the analysis of pre board examination results of students enrolled at Koteshwor Multiple Campus for the academic year 2079/80. The analysis focuses on student participation, gender distribution, subject-wise performance challenges, and overall academic outcomes.

The main purpose of this report is to understand the pattern of success, failure, and absenteeism among students and to provide evidence-based recommendations for improving academic performance in the upcoming academic years.

2. Student Enrollment and Participation Overview

The total number of admitted students in the academic year 2079/80 was 557. Among them, 261 students appeared in the final examination. However, only 331 students were recorded as active students, indicating that a significant portion of admitted students either dropped out, did not register for examinations, or remained absent.

The table shows that more than half of admitted students did not appear in the examination, which indicates retention and participation challenges that require institutional attention.

3. Gender Distribution of Students

Among the total active students female students represent a significantly higher proportion compared to male students.

The data indicates that female student enrollment and participation are higher than male students, which reflects positive gender inclusion but also suggests that male student retention may need improvement.

4. Subject-wise Failure and Absenteeism Analysis

The analysis of subject-wise results shows that Account, Statistics, and Economics have high numbers of failure and absenteeism cases.

The data reveals that **Economics** has the highest number of unsuccessful students, followed by **Account** and **Statistics**. This indicates serious academic difficulty in core subjects, particularly in Economics.

5. Key Findings and Interpretation

Several important observations can be drawn from the result analysis:

First, there is a large gap between admitted students and those appearing in examinations, suggesting issues related to attendance, academic preparedness, financial constraints, or student motivation.

Second, female student participation is higher than male participation, which indicates successful female enrollment initiatives but possible disengagement among male students.

Third, subject-wise analysis shows extremely high failure and absenteeism rates, particularly in Economics. This may be due to difficulty level of the subject, teaching methodology, lack of conceptual understanding, or insufficient academic support.

Fourth, the high number of failures in Statistics suggests language proficiency challenges, especially for students from Nepali-medium educational backgrounds.

Fifth, Account also shows a high failure rate, which may be associated with mathematical difficulty, lack of practice, or insufficient academic guidance.

Thus, the data indicates the need for academic intervention programs to improve student outcomes.

6. Possible Causes of Poor Performance

Based on academic logic and institutional experience, the following factors may have contributed to poor results:

- Irregular student attendance
- Lack of subject-wise remedial classes
- Weak academic foundation from previous education levels
- Insufficient practice and tutorial support
- Examination fear and low confidence among students
- Economic and personal challenges affecting student participation
- Limited academic counseling and mentoring services

7. Recommendations for Improvement

- i. Regular remedial and coaching classes should be conducted for academically weak students, particularly in challenging subjects such as Economics, Account, and Statistics, to improve their conceptual understanding and examination performance.
- ii. Academic monitoring mechanisms should be strengthened by closely tracking student attendance, assignment completion, internal assessments, and classroom participation to ensure consistent academic engagement.
- iii. Statistics language support programs, including communication skill development and basic language improvement classes, should be introduced to help students overcome language barriers that affect learning outcomes.
- iv. Additional tutorial sessions, group discussions, and practice-oriented learning activities should be organized, especially for numerical and analytical subjects like Account and Economics, to enhance problem-solving skills.

- v. Academic counseling and faculty mentorship systems should be implemented to provide guidance, motivation, and psychological support to students facing academic difficulties or lack of confidence.
- vi. An early identification and support system should be developed to detect students with low attendance, poor internal performance, or irregular participation so that timely academic intervention and support can be provided.

8. Conclusion

The result assessment of the academic year 2079/80 indicates that although student enrollment is satisfactory, examination participation and academic performance remain significant challenges at Koteswor Multiple Campus. High failure rates in core subjects such as Economics, Account, and Statistics highlight the need for structured academic support mechanisms.

By implementing targeted interventions such as remedial classes, mentoring systems, and improved teaching strategies, the campus can significantly enhance student success rates in future academic years. Continuous monitoring and evaluation of academic performance will be essential to ensure institutional quality and academic excellence.
